

## Samurai:

### Materials needed:

- Swim noodle, cut in two (Or a foam sword) as your Samurai sword.
- Papers with references (Scripture Mastery or a lesson reference, if the game is used as a review)
- Arrange the tables into a circle or square. The samurai will be in the middle of the tables.
- The desks should be cleared of everything (including scriptures) unless they still need their bookmarks to know the references.
- In front of each student needs to be a paper hanging from the front of the table with a reference (for example, 1 Nephi 3:7)

### To play:

- The teacher starts it by calling out someone's key words. The person with that reference written in front of their desk needs to call out another person's key words before the samurai hits their **DESK (not student)** with the noodle.
- Then the student with the scripture associated with those key words needs to call another's key words... If the student's desk is hit before another's key words are said, then the samurai sits in their spot and that person becomes the new samurai.
- There will be one more student than spots to sit and you can only do as many spots (and scripture references) as you have students (maximum 25).
- To change things up, students all move one chair to the right.
